Discover WFDD's Hike & Bike Trails

Designed as part of the District's 2011 Parks Master Plan, WFDD has completed its approximate 15-mile trail expansion to create nearly 45 miles of off-street trails for community connectivity and better access to local and regional destinations. "The beauty of such an expansive trail system is that residents are able to hop on at many different locations rather than needing to drive to one specific entry point to access the trails," said Glen Jarrett with TBG Partners, the District's landscape architect, Overall trail system maps appear at destination spaces, such as Willow Fork and Exploration Parks, and at high traffic $intersections. \ Trailhead, way finding \ and \ street \ crossing \ signage \ help \ visitors$ navigate, and quarter mile markers correspond to a gridded map for both $\ distance\ tracking\ and\ location\ information\ for\ emergency\ response.\ Where\ space$ allows, plaza areas with bench seating have been added.
