


Open to the public daily year-round, WFDD's three managed parks offer a variety

of outdoor experiences for visitors, from gardens, walking and bike paths, disc

golf, play areas, and shaded pavilions at Willow Fork and Exploration parks, to community events, classes and concerts at Central Green. While funded by resident tax dollars, the parks are open to the greater community. For this reason, WFDD does not accept reservations for groups of any size at its park facilities, so they remain accessible to all District residents. The pavilion areas at Willow Fork and Exploration parks are available on a first-come, first-served basis for gatherings of no more than 20 but are not available for private use that excludes other park visitors. WFDD will consider proposals for private or hosted events at Central Green, keeping in mind its primary commitment to provide residents access to its outdoor spaces. 
