You May Be Entitled to Recovery if Your Home Flooded in Harvey

Town Hall to Address Flood Recovery Options/Deadline

With only six months left to file a claim, don't miss the third in a series of town hall meetings at **7 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 23**, at Cinco Ranch Junior High, 23420 Cinco Ranch Blvd., Katy, TX 77494.

Representatives from Fort Bend County will share important information for anyone who flooded upstream of Barker Reservoir during Hurricane Harvey. [View a map showing Harvey impacted litigation area.](#) Updates on the one-time opportunity for homeowners whose properties flooded to seek recovery if their home falls within the flood easement will be available, including:

- Status of the Addicks and Barker upstream takings litigation
- Deadline for making a damage recovery claim
- How to start a claim
- What is being done to protect properties impacted by Harvey in the future

Representatives from Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP and The AL Law Group PLLC also will be on hand to cover topics and answer questions.
