Did Your Home Flood During Hurricane Harvey?

Town Hall to Address Flood Recovery Options

Don't miss the second in a series of town hall meetings hosted by Fort Bend County with important information for anyone who flooded upstream of Barker Reservoir during Hurricane Harvey. View a map showing Harvey impacted litigation area.

Fort Bend County Judge K.P. George and Dwayne Grigar, director of county Planning and Infrastructure, will open the meeting at **7 p.m. on Jan. 24** at Betty Sue Creech Elementary, 5905 Mason Rd, Katy, TX 77450. Updates on the one-time opportunity for homeowners whose properties flooded to seek recovery if their home falls within the flood easement will be available, including:

- · Status of the Addicks and Barker upstream takings litigation
- · Deadline for making a damage recovery claim
- How to start a claim
- · What is being done to protect properties impacted by Harvey in the future

Representatives from Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP and The AL Law Group PLLC also will be on hand to cover topics and answer questions.
