Did Your Home Flood in Harvey?

Attend a Town Hall to Learn About Potential Recovery

The next town hall meeting to address recovery options for residents whose homes flooded in Hurricane Harvey will be at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 21, at McMeans Jr. High, 21000 Westheimer Parkway, Katy, TX 77450. **Please note this is a date change from the postcard mailer that was distributed.**

Representatives from Fort Bend County will share important information for anyone who flooded upstream of Barker Reservoir during Hurricane Harvey. [View a map showing Harvey inundation litigation area.](#) Updates on the one-time opportunity for homeowners whose properties flooded to seek recovery if their home falls within the flood easement will be available, including:

- Status of the Addicks and Barker upstream takings litigation
- Deadline for making a damage recovery claim
- How to start a claim
- What is being done to protect properties impacted by Harvey in the future

Representatives from Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP and The AL Law Group PLLC also will be on hand to cover topics and answer questions.
