The Board of Directors of Willow Fork Drainage District will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, April 25, 2024, at 11:30 a.m.**, at the offices of LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 100, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

 - e. update on Fry Road Underpass, including discuss Harris County Precinct 4 grant;
 - f. authorize appropriate action regarding shade structures at Central Green and Willow Fork Park; and
 - g. authorize design of new projects.

 - a. Fry Road Underpass;
 - b. Cinco Ranch Boulevard underpass;
 - c. Enchanted Meadow Midblock Crossing;
 - d. status of ongoing repairs to facilities; and
 - e. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.

 - a. Trail Detour Routes;
 - b. discuss timing for Mason Road sidewalk improvements project; and
 - c. potential joint projects with Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 12, including discuss scheduling next joint meeting.

12. Report regarding Central Green events and Parks Committee recommendations and approve contracts for events, as appropriate, discuss park operations, and authorize appropriate action.
