WILLOW FORK DRAINAGE DISTRICT FORT BEND AND HARRIS COUNTIES, TEXAS

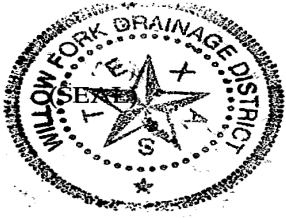
The Board of Directors of Willow Fork Drainage District hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, July 9, 2026, at 11:30 a.m.**, at the offices of LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 100, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills and review of investments;
 - b. five-year cash flow; and
 - c. resolution(s) expressing intent to reimburse.
4. Champions report on operation of District facilities, repairs, and maintenance, including ditch maintenance and desilting projects, update on priority list for additional repairs; and, if applicable, approval of any necessary proposals for regular, additional or revised maintenance schedules.
5. Lake management and maintenance matters, including review proposals and authorize appropriate action.
6. Report from Inframark, LLC, including:
 - a. update on closeout of FEMA claim; and
 - b. maintenance of storm sewer lines, including approval of any necessary maintenance and repair proposals and update on ownership of manholes/inlets.
7. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. discuss Diversion Channel outfall erosion and proposed desilting plan, including maintenance agreement with Grand Lakes Water Control and Improvement District;
 - b. design of District facilities and authorization to advertise for bids, including:
 - i. Va9 rehabilitation;
 - ii. Va3b rehabilitation; and
 - iii. Va10 rehabilitation;
 - c. review bids and award contracts for construction projects;
 - d. status of ongoing improvements and repairs to District facilities, including approve pay estimate, change orders, termination, settlement agreements, litigation, substantial completion, and final acceptance and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, including:
 - i. Va12 rehabilitation; and

- ii. Cinco Ranch Boulevard Underpass;
 - e. land acquisition and conveyance matters, including deeds, easements, abandonments; and
 - f. capital improvement plan.
- 8. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
- 9. Park matters and Park Manager/Park Committee matters, including:
 - a. update on Trail Package 4, including acquisition of easements and rights-of-way, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, and approve pay estimates, change orders, substantial completion, and final completion and acceptance for the following:
 - i. Segments X, Y, and Z;
 - ii. Segment Q, Section 1, including installation of trail from Mason Road to Fry Road;
 - iii. Segment Q, Section 2, including installation of trail east of Fry Road and construction of pedestrian bridge and underpass; and
 - iv. required mitigation for Segments X, Y, and Z and Q trail projects;
 - b. design of Central Green bollards and Green Room;
 - c. pay estimates, change orders, substantial completion, and final completion and acceptance for the following:
 - i. Mason Road sidewalk improvements, including report on fiber contractor damage within project area; and
 - ii. Central Green turf replacement;
 - d. discuss LaCenterra access trails, including Cinco Ranch Boulevard sidewalk improvements;
 - e. cul de sac sidewalk trail connections to District trails;
 - f. North Fort Bend Water Authority Va3b surface water line project;
 - g. approve contracts for events, as appropriate;
 - h. discuss park operations and employment matters and authorize appropriate action.
- 10. Reports from Directors and Committees, regarding correspondence and/or reports received during the month and events and activities attended during the month, including:
 - a. Houston Stronger report; and
 - b. report on current events.
